Cal Thomas
"Media Bias"

Writes a twice weekly, nationally syndicated newspaper column distributed to more than 450 papers through the Los Angeles Times Syndicate. He is a frequent contributor of commentary and analysis to television and radio, currently for the Fox News Network. He has guest hosted Cable News Network's *Crossfire* and has appeared on the *Phil Donahue Show*, ABC's *Nightline*, *Good Morning America*, *The CBS Morning News*, NBC's *Today* and *The Oprah Winfrey Show*. He has worked for NBC News and Public Television and has won numerous reporting awards. He was a 1995 Cable Ace Award Nominee for the best interview program on cable. Mr. Thomas is the author of nine books, including, "***The Things That Matter Most***". His latest book, "***Blinded by Might: Why the Religious Right Has Failed!***", is scheduled for release in March of 1999.

Star Parker
"Welfare"

President of Coalition on Urban Renewal and Education, (C.U.R.E.) A former welfare recipient, Star has been dubbed "the brightest light in the black conservative movement . . . a woman to watch", by Rush Limbaugh. Her book "***Pimps, Whores and Welfare Brats***", chronicles her life from a militant high school student and welfare addict, to a successful Christian business woman and mother.

Matt Staver
"Judicial Tyranny"

Founder and President of Liberty Counsel, a religious civil liberties education and legal defense organization established to preserve religious freedom. Mr. Staver is also the founder of The Staver Group, a governmental consulting and lobbying organization for pro-family, religious liberty and private education issues. He is author of "***Faith and Freedom***", and host of two radio programs.

Cliff Kincaid
"National Sovereignty / UN"

Investigative journalist and author, who once served as a co-host on CNN's *Crossfire*, hosted a radio talk show, records commentaries for Accuracy in Media, and authors the "Washington Watch" column for *The American Legion Magazine*. Founded and directs the American Sovereignty Action Project, (ASAP). Recognized as one of the leading experts on the United Nations affairs, his Jan. 19, 1997 *Washington Post* article, "***Who's Soaking Whom?***" helped spark Congressional efforts to resist payment of a phony "debt" to the UN. His Jan. 31, 1997 *Washington Times*, article about Maurice Strong, who just stepped down as UN "reform" coordinator, exposed his advocacy of global taxes and world government, euphemistically called "global governance". His latest book, "***Global Taxes for World Government***", is based on official documents and statements by UN officials and non-government organizations, (NGOs).

Senator John Ashcroft

A Republican Presidential candidate for the year 2000. Before his election to the U.S. Senate in 1994, Mr. Ashcroft served Missourians as their governor for two terms, balancing eight consecutive budgets. He is the author of the landmark "***Charitable Choice***" provision of the new welfare reform law, which allows states to work directly with charities and faith-based organizations to move people from dependence to work. His 10-point plan, "***The Pro-Family Tax Overhaul***", would provide relief for families by making payroll taxes deductible, ending the marriage penalty and reducing marginal income tax rates.

Herbert W. Titus
"Accountability"

Lawyer, author, educator and President of Forecast Foundation, a non-profit educational organization. He has worked as an ACLU attorney. Now a practicing attorney in Virginia Beach, specializing in constitutional litigation and strategy, and founding Dean of the College of Law and Government at Regent University. He taught constitutional law at Oregon, Oklahoma and Colorado Universities and currently serves on the legal defense team of Michael New, the American soldier who refused to serve under the United Nations command.

Avi Lipkin
"Is Islam a Global Threat?"

A spokesman for the Israeli Defense Force (reserves), a former Sr. Editor and Translator for the Israeli Government press office under Prime Minister Shamir. He received his MA at Israel's Conservative Jewish Seminary. He has spoken to numerous churches, synagogues and civic groups offering compelling proof that *the fanaticism of Islam is the number one threat to world peace today*. In his book, **"Is Fanatic Islam A Global Threat"?**, Avi presents his belief that Christians and Jews must forge an alliance to stop Islam's secret goal to destroy Judaism and Christianity and dominate the world.
